

Course Substitutions

A set of courses, including a set of one course, may be substituted for a required set of courses, including a set of one course, in a curriculum if the set being substituted is the functional equivalent of the required set. In no case will substitutions be permitted which would allow completion of a program without meeting all student learning outcomes for that program. Specific course requirements mandated by the State of North Carolina for a particular program may not be substituted. All substitutions must be approved by the program faculty, the associated division dean/director, and the chief academic officer.
